

ORDINANCE NO. 587

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF WOLFFORTH, TEXAS, CALLING A GENERAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON MAY 7, 2022, FOR THE PURPOSE OF ELECTING THE MAYOR AND FOUR COUNCILMEMBERS; MAKING PROVISION FOR THE CONDUCT OF SUCH ELECTION ACCORDING TO APPLICABLE PROVISIONS OF LAW; PROVIDING FOR EXECUTION OF AN APPROPRIATE ELECTIONS ORDER AND NOTICE HEREAFTER; AND OTHER PROVISIONS INCIDENT TO AND RELATED TO THE PURPOSE HEREOF.

WHEREAS, the terms of the office of the mayor and two Council members expire on May 7, 2022;

WHEREAS, since the May 2021 election, two of the Council members elected as a result of the May 2021 election have resigned;

WHEREAS, the Council appointed an individual to fill a vacancy created in July 2021;

WHEREAS, the second vacancy occurred in January 2022, and the Council is considering the appointment of an individual to fill that vacancy;

WHEREAS, state law requires that individuals appointed to fill a vacancy serve until the next regular municipal election; and

WHEREAS, a general municipal election is necessary to fill these terms of office; **NOW THEREFORE;**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WOLFFORTH AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. THAT a General Municipal Election be held jointly with all cities/schools inside Lubbock County, on the 7th day of May 2022 which date is the next succeeding uniform date available for municipal elections for which sufficient time elapses for the holding of an election after passage of this Ordinance. Said election shall be held to determine the successor for the positions of the mayor and four Councilmembers.

SECTION 3. THAT ballots shall be prepared in accordance with the applicable provisions of the Texas Election Code so that voters may cast ballots for the candidates of their choice.

SECTION 4. THAT individuals wishing to run for the office of Mayor or a Councilmember may apply, in person, with the City Secretary during regular office hours, 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday, beginning at 8:00 a.m. on Wednesday, January 19, 2022, and ending at 5:00 p.m. on Friday, February 18, 2022.

SECTION 5. THAT the election shall be held at the Vote Centers listed in Exhibit B and all persons qualified to vote in the City of Wolfforth under the election laws of the State of Texas shall be allowed to vote therein. Said General Municipal Election shall be held on May 7, 2022, and the polling places shall be open from 7:00 A.M. to 7:00 P.M.

SECTION 6. THAT notice of the election shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the City of Wolfforth by publication of a Notice of Election as required by Chapter 4 of the Texas Election Code at least once not earlier than the 30th day or later than the 10th day before Election Day. In addition, notice of the election shall be posted as required by the Texas Election Code.

SECTION 7. THAT early voting shall commence on the 25th day of April 2022 and shall conclude on the 3rd day of May 2022 and be conducted at the sites and during the hours listed on Exhibit A; that May 2, 2022 and any other day designated by the Lubbock County Office of Elections are designated as the twelve-hour days for early voting; and that the Office of Elections, 1308 Crickets Ave., Lubbock, Texas, serves as the main early voting polling place.

SECTION 8. THAT applications for voting by mail will be accepted until 5:00 p.m. Tuesday, April 26, 2022, and applications are available from:


SECTION 9. THAT the election officers, judges, and clerks to serve at the polling place(s) of the election shall be provided by the Lubbock County Office of Elections, and will be appointed as listed:

Early Voting Ballot Board Alternate Judge:	Ruth Martinez
Signature Verification Committee:	Mary Ann Bridges, Chair Charles Britton: Vice Chair
Central Count Manager:	Roxzine Stinson

Central Count Presiding Judge:	Tom Grimes

SECTION 10. THAT the election judges and the election clerks shall be paid according to the pay schedule established by the Lubbock County Office of Elections.

SECTION 11. THAT this ordinance shall be effective immediately upon its final passage.
